

ACKSYS USBPORT

CMD UNINSTALLER

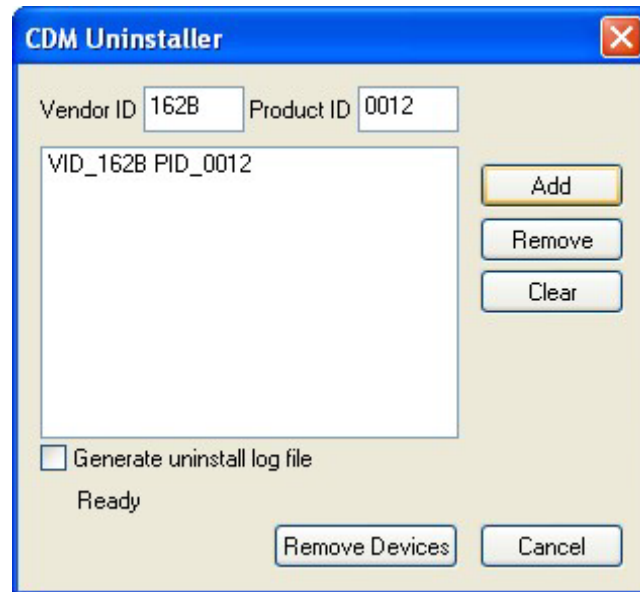
This readme file will give an overview of the functionality of the USBPORT CDM Uninstaller. This application is used to remove installed **USBPORT** device drivers from the user's system and clean them from the Windows registry.

Running the Application

To run the application, simply double click on the .exe file.

Removing the Driver

The figure below shows the main window of the application. Enter the USBPORT Vendor ID and Device ID in the corresponding text boxes, respectively **0x162B** and **0x0012**, then Add the product into the device window:



To remove the device, click on the '*Remove Devices*' button.

A message box will confirm successful removal from the system and the device will be removed from the device window. To create an uninstall log file, check 'Generate uninstall log file' prior to removing the device. This will create a text file outlining all operations that were attempted during the removal process that will be saved in the same directory as the .exe file.



Error Messages

If the message "Remove Failed" appears, check the Vendor ID and Device ID, and make sure that the device has been specified within the window by using the '*Add*' button. This message can also appear if the device has already been removed.
